Role

The Church Engagement Associate works with the MCEC staff team to energize congregations in worship, discipleship and mission; encourage leaders of hope, vision and transformation; and embody God's reconciling ministry for all creation. By speaking regularly in congregations and helping to organize regional church gatherings, the Church Engagement Associate helps congregations grow in their awareness of sibling congregations and the shared ministry of the wider church. The ideal candidate enjoys meeting new people, connecting others and sharing their learning. They are excited by the opportunity to visit congregations and speak in a variety of church settings across the region. The candidate is deeply committed to the church and passionate about nurturing new expressions of Christian community and mission. This is a part-time (20 hr/week) limited term contract.

Requirements – Work Experience and Education

- Bachelors degree, with training in theology or ministry preferred
- Experience in church ministry, either as a volunteer or paid staff

- Excellent ability to communicate in English, both spoken and written (French is as asset)
- Experienced public speaker with demonstrated ability to engage diverse audiences
- Proven interpersonal skills, with an ability to engage individuals from a broad range of theological and political perspectives
- Access to transportation for travel throughout MCEC's constituent region
- Membership in an MCEC congregation

Requirements - Attributes

- Entrepreneurial and creative
- Self-directed and dependable, able to represent MCEC with minimal supervision
- Experienced by others as a person of integrity and faith
- Embodies MCEC's values and supports MCEC's identity and priorities

Responsibilities

- Research and prepare talks on topics of interest to MCEC congregations (e.g., creation care, youth ministry, intergenerational faith formation, justice ministries, peace)
- Research and share stories of congregational life, including examples of MCEC congregations engaging in critical and creative ministries
- Speak in congregations 2+ times per month, in person and via Zoom
- Connect with congregational committee leaders to assist congregations in learning from each other and connecting them with the wider church
- Collaborate with the MCEC staff team, including participation in regular Tuesday team meetings, to plan regional worship, equipping events and speaking appointments
- Record information and contacts generated by congregational engagements
