Term

- Half-time (0.5 FTE)
- Renewable term beginning September 1st, 2023 August 31st, 2026 with a review before the end of the first year.

Accountability

- The pastor is accountable to the congregation through Ministry Leadership Team (Council); and
- The Pastor-Congregation Relations Committee (which helps to maintain a healthy relationship between the pastor and the congregation)

Qualifications

- Preferred a Master of Theological Studies or Master of Divinity degree, preferably from a Mennonite educational institution (AMBS, CMU, Conrad Grebel), with an emphasis in pastoral training
- Credentialing recognized by MCEC or willingness to attain those credentials
- Rooted in our Anabaptist/Mennonite faith tradition
- Experience successfully pastoring a congregation which is experiencing change
- Committed to respect the principles and policies of MC Canada and MCEC as represented in the Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective, Mennonite Polity including but not limited to, A Shared Understanding of Church Leadership

Attributes

- Effective speaker and teacher
- Works well within a team leadership approach
- Serve as a resource to Ministry Leadership Team, Worship Planning Team and meets with Pastoral Team
- Effectively communicate information for optimal functioning of the congregation

Broader Church and Community Involvement

- Attend meetings of the Wilmot Mennonite Ministerial Cluster as needed
- May serve as a delegate to the spring and fall gatherings of Mennonite Church Eastern Canada
- May participate in events of MCEC in consultation with MLT, take on MCEC committee assignments
