

Brussels Mennonite Fellowship – Pastoral Job Description

1. Preaching and Teaching

To be responsible for the preaching / teaching ministry of the congregation, encouraging people to grow in maturity of faith, discipleship and mission. To preach an average of 3 Sundays a month.

2. Discernment and Vision Casting

To guide the leadership team in discerning God's purpose for His church in this place. To lead the congregation in honouring this purpose.

3. Spiritual Growth

To initiate and work with leaders in growing disciples through nurturing and equipping; to instruct or arrange for instruction of new believers.

4. Pastoral Care

To actively connect with the lives of the people of Brussels Mennonite Fellowship through visitation, with priority given to the sick and aged. To work with leadership in ministry, with the Pastoral care team on crisis care. Administer ordinances, officiate at marriages and conduct funerals.

5. Communication

To effectively share information with the congregation regarding congregational life. To share opportunities for prayer, spiritual growth, mission, etc. To work with Church council and attend meetings for the purpose of congregational administration.

6. Worship Planning

To work with the Worship Coordinating Team in designing and leading meaningful, inspirational worship, encouraging a deeper relationship with our Lord.
